“It’s a good feeling to know the work we do behind the scenes can make such a difference for our patients and staff,” say Kevin Gillan and Robert Briscoe, members of the RVH maintenance team.

The newly renovated rooms on the second floor provide patients with more comfort and privacy for their hospital stay.

“The new space also allows us to better meet infection control guidelines in order to keep all of our patients safe,” adds Jessica Gilbert, Nurse Manager of the Active Care Unit.

Patients really appreciate the changes, which include:

- elimination of ward rooms (three or four patients in one room)—the entire Active Care Unit now consists of either semi-private or private rooms
- addition of new bathrooms in patient care areas—designed with patient use, comfort, accessibility and infection control in mind
- dedicated hand hygiene sinks in each patient room for infection control purposes
- innovative new patient care design with new headwalls behind patient beds to house oxygen, suction, and power equipment.

“We are very pleased with the renovations completed so far,” says Gilbert.

Through the *I Choose RVH* initiative, our community is invited to support the most significant redevelopment in the hospital’s history.
