Randy has built relationships and fostered integration with partners, overseen renovations and expansions, established new programs and services, and along the way mentored many aspiring healthcare leaders.

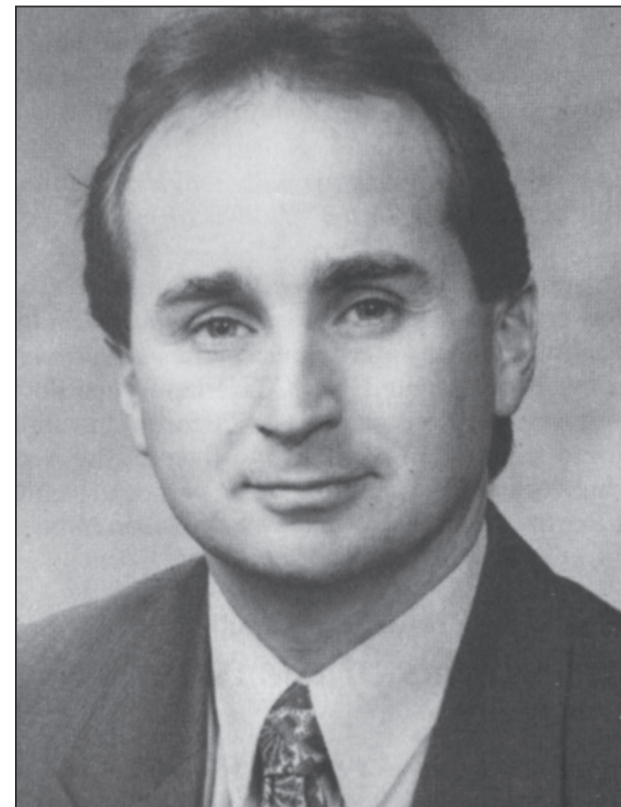

He has also worked tirelessly to ensure that RVH serves the needs of the people in our community and that the future of our community hospital is secure and sustainable.

In June 2020, after three decades of steering the ship, Randy is stepping down as CEO of RVH and St. Francis Memorial Hospital in Barry's Bay.
