Renewing medical prescriptions during the COVID-19 pandemic

From the Emergency Department of Renfrew Victoria Hospital

In the near future, we anticipate that an increased burden will be placed upon our Emergency Department (ED) as we deal with COVID-19 patients.

In order to protect the non-ill public and position the hospital for this increased need, we are trying to minimize all non-emergent use of our department.

To this end, Renfrew Victoria Hospital has formed a partnership with our local pharmacies allowing any patient on chronic medications to have their existing prescriptions renewed without the need to see a physician.

Patients can present directly to their local pharmacies to have their prescriptions renewed.

We ask that all patients take advantage of this temporary courtesy and not present to the ED for prescription renewals.
